Request for Proposal (RFP)

The City of Clarkston, Georgia is requesting competitive proposals from qualified vendors to conduct a greenway connectivity feasibility study. The selected consultant will conduct an extensive public outreach process to develop a connectivity study for the City of Clarkston. It is anticipated that the consultant will work with the staff and community to produce a phased connectivity feasibility study with an extensive public outreach process that will incorporate upcoming and countywide trails and park plans. The study should include an analysis of and recommendations for pedestrian access/connectivity to infrastructure, parks and trails, and other amenities, as well as the impact this increased connectivity will have on residential occupancy.

Emailed proposals will be received until 3:30 PM local time on November 30, 2022, at the following address; clarkstongreenway@cityofclarkston.com **Attention: Shawanna N. Qawiy, City Manager's Office.** Late proposals will not be considered nor returned.

The competitive proposal shall include separate tabs for the technical approach(s) and price submission(s). Proposals will be evaluated based on the criteria formulated by the City for the most important features of this project with price as one component of the overall evaluation process.

Proposals may be submitted by e-mail. Facsimile (fax) proposals will not be accepted. All proposals must be received on or prior to the day and time specified. Proposals will be formally accepted and acknowledged by staff personnel.

Payment will be made in accordance with the Payment Plan agreed upon at execution of this contract. The Bidding Documents and Specifications are only available for review and download at the City of Clarkston website: www.clarkstonga.gov. Individual meetings with City staff regarding the RFP will not be permissible.

Proposals may not be withdrawn for sixty (60) days after the time and date set for proposal submissions. The City of Clarkston reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive technicalities.
