**Clarkston Police Department Award \$10,000 Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) Incentive Grant**

Clarkston Police Dept. has been awarded a public safety partnership grant totaling \$10,000 from the Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) in Atlanta.

The incentive grant, which will last through September of this year, is designed for smaller law enforcement agencies that have partnered with GOHS and excelled in participating in highway safety initiatives as well as making their communities safe during the previous year.

The goal of the grant is to reward agencies for their proactive approach to traffic safety and to provide them with the necessary tools to effectively continue their lifesaving efforts. With this grant, the Police Department will be able to acquire safety equipment that will protect the officers and the public during safety inspections and to replace several outdated MTDs (unit computers) and upgraded them with (6) new Dell computers replacement units.
