

**A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING A
VACANCY ON THE CITY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Councilman Robert Hogan has announced that he is moving his residence out of Clarkston effective today; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides that a vacancy is created when a councilperson moves his residence from the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has declared a vacancy on the City Council pursuant to City Charter § 2.05(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Clarkston City Council as follows:

- 1) The vacancy in the office of Councilperson, as declared by the Mayor, is hereby affirmed;
- 2) Councilman Robert Hogan's seat on the City Council is hereby declared vacant;
- 3) The City Manager is hereby directed to inform the DeKalb County Board of Registrations and Elections of the vacancy in the office of Councilperson so that such Board of Elections can call a special election to fill the vacancy in the office of Councilperson for the remainder of Mr. Hogan's unexpired term;
- 4) Such special election shall be held on March 21, 2017, pursuant to City Charter § 2.05(c) and O.C.G.A. § 21-2-540(C)(1)(A)(i); and
- 5) The qualified individual elected to fill the vacancy on the City Council at such special election shall be sworn in at the regular meeting of the City Council held April 4, 2017, and shall serve the remainder of Councilman Hogan's term, which expires December 31, 2017.
