

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CLARKSTON ADOPTING THE 2016-2040 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Georgia Planning Act of 1989 authorizes local governments throughout the State to prepare Comprehensive Plans to be used in guiding their future growth and development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clarkston, pursuant to the implementation requirements of its Comprehensive Plan, has prepared a five-year update to its Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the five-year update of the Comprehensive Plan was prepared in accordance with the Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures for Local Comprehensive Planning established by the Georgia Planning Act of 1989, and a public hearing was properly advertised and held on June 7th 2016 at the City of Clarkston City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the five-year update of the Comprehensive Plan were properly submitted to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs and the Atlanta Regional Commission for review, and each has determined that the five-year update of the Comprehensive Plan adequately addresses the requirements of the Minimum Standards and Procedures for Local Comprehensive Planning.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the City of Clarkston hereby adopts the five-year update to its Comprehensive Plan that is attached consisting of 79 pages.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the City of Clarkston hereby authorizes this resolution to be submitted to the Atlanta Regional Commission and Georgia Department of Community Affairs.
