The Governing Authority of the City of Clarkston has tentatively adopted a 2018 millage rate which will require an increase in the property taxes of 13.09 percent.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Clarkston will hold three (3) public hearings to discuss and take public comment on the proposed 2018 millage rate. The City Council has proposed and advertised the proposed rate of 17.50 mills, which is an increase of 2.026 mills over the rollback rate, of 15.474.

The first public hearing will be held on Wednesday, June 27, 2018 at 10:00am in the Clarkston Council Room, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021.

The second public hearing will be held on Wednesday, June 27, 2018 at 6:30pm in the Clarkston Council Room, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021.

The final public hearing will be held at the Clarkston City Hall on July 5 at 7:00PM, during the regular Council Meeting, in the Council Room, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021. The Clarkston City Council will vote to adopt the 2018 Millage Rate directly following the final Public Hearing. All concerned residents are invited to the public hearings.
