

PRESS RELEASE

The Governing Authority of the City of Clarkston has tentatively adopted a 2017 millage rate which will require an increase in the property taxes of 14.95 percent.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Clarkston will hold three (3) public hearings to discuss and take public comment on the proposed 2017 millage rate. The City Council has proposed and advertised the proposed rate of 15.89 mills, which is the same millage rate as the adopted 2016 millage rate. The rollback rate, is 13.824.

The first public hearing will be held on Thursday, June 29, 2017 at 10:00am in the Clarkston Council Room, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021.

The second public hearing will be held on June 29, 2017 at 6:00pm in the Clarkston Council Room, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021.

The final public hearing will be held at the Clarkston City Hall on July 6, 2017, at 7:30 pm, during the regular Council Meeting, in the Council Room, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021. The Clarkston City Council will vote to adopt the 2017 Millage Rate directly following the final Public Hearing. All concerned residents are invited to the public hearings.
