(Clarkston, GA)— In response to help prevent the spread of the current Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), the City of Clarkston reminds everyone to consider options and practices that promote good health including:

➤ **PLEASE GET YOUR COVID-19 VACCINE ! ! ! !**

- **WEAR A FACE COVERING/MASK IF YOU HAVE NOT BEEN VACCINATED**
- **Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds**
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth**
- ***Maintain prudent social distance (6 feet) from others, particularly if you have not been vaccinated***

- **Clarkston Public Works** continue maintaining streets/rights-of-ways (ROW) as well as trash/debris control. Any street, ROW, parks, stormwater, or other needing attention, please call: **678.409.9683**.
- Waste Management **residential trash collection** continues each **Monday** and is being supplemented by Clarkston Public Works. Latham Home Sanitation **recycling collection** continues each Monday.
- **Milam Park** is now open sunrise to sunset; **City Playgrounds and Park Bathrooms/Water fountains, will be open during park hours.**
