Milam Pool is Now Open with Reduced Capacity. See Rules and Operational hours below.

Pool Guidelines

To keep the pool safe we ask patrons to follow these guidelines:

Large floats or inner tubes are not permitted, as they obstruct the view of the lifeguards. Water guns, throwing toys or other items that may cause harm are prohibited. Small floating toys or pouring toys are acceptable for tots. Safety of items will be determined at the discretion of the pool staff.

Children may wear coastguard-approved PFDs' with close parental supervision.

Patrons swimming with children who wear diapers must use "leak proof" baby swim diapers, or diapers covered with snug-fitting plastic pants.

Parents are encouraged to accompany their children to the pool and to supervise them closely while in the water. They are also asked to discuss pool safety rules with their children and to encourage respect for pool rules and pool staff.

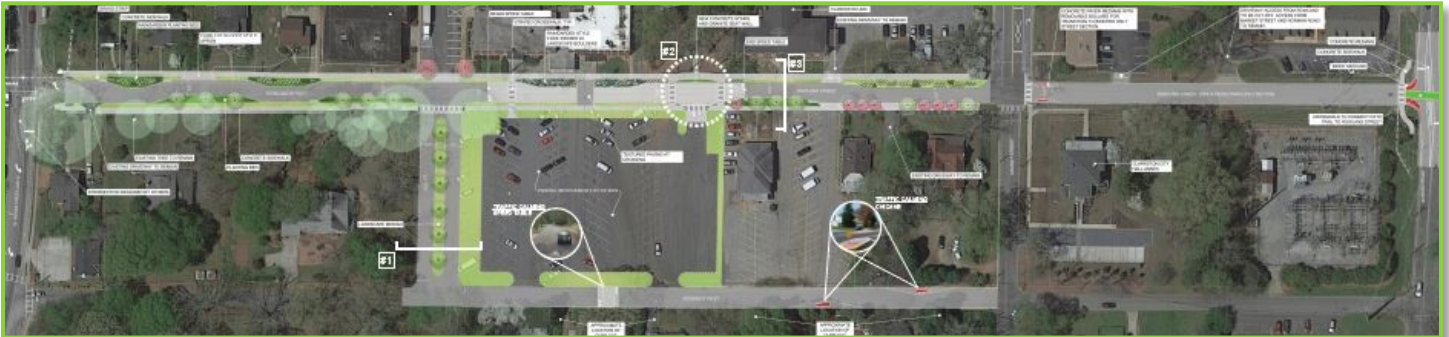

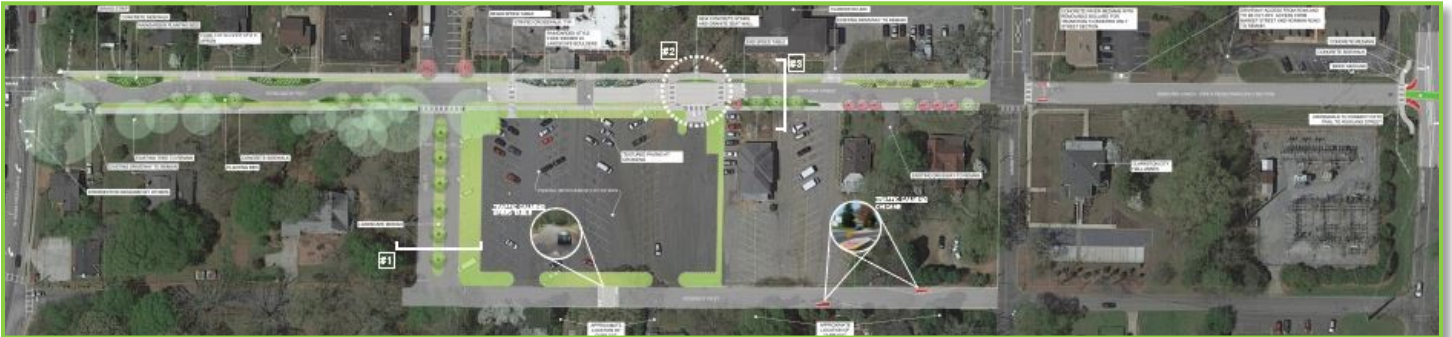

CITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS



Project	Description
Rowland Street Road Diet & Mell Ave Trail-head	Project construction from trailhead to Norman Rd on Rowland. Road closure on Rowland from North Indian Creek to Market commenced on 5/1/2021. Expect closure thru September 2021. Work entails new granite curb on Rowland from NIC to Market, new sidewalks, traffic calming measures, trees, asphalt resurfacing, bioswales, Clarkston Trolley Information kiosk, streetscape benches, road narrowing and pedestrian crossing improvements
Rowland Street from Lovejoy to North Indian Creek	Sidewalk to be placed on the north side of Rowland and reset granite curb with road width reduction from 24 feet to 20 feet. Road to be resurfaced with new striping and easabout at the intersection of Wagoner and Rowland Street. Construction commenced on 5/17/2021. Road to remain open during construction. Construction duration to be approximately 3 months
Rogers St from Market to North Indian Creek	Traffic calming and sidewalk on north side of Rogers Street. Work to commence in late 2021 or early 2022
Rowland Street from Market St to Norman Rd	Traffic calming installation and sidewalk installation on the south side Work to commence late 2021
Peachtree Creek at Ponce New Apartment Complete on EPDL	Traffic delays due to developer installing new left and right turn lanes into new development

CITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS Con't



Project	Description
Debelle Street Stormwater and Roadway Improvements	Partnership with State of Georgia Board of Education, Nelkin Enterprise and City to build detention pond is 95% complete. Expect work to be completed by June 30 th , 2021. No traffic delays anticipated
Streetscape Project	Project is 99% complete. Punch list tasks remain. Expect 100% completion by June 30 th , 2021.
Peachtree on Ponce Apartments – addition of left turn lane on East Ponce de Leon	One lane open to traffic with flaggers during construction
Church at East Ponce sidewalk Project (PH 2)	City signed 2 CSX agreements. CSX to sign and execute agreements. Phase 2 will commence with sidewalks on the CSX side of Church and EPDL including traffic islands on EPDL for pedestrian crossings (with 3 new rectangular rapid flashing beacons) – same as installed on Montreal Road Anticipate construction to commence in July 2021
