City of Clarkston - Public Health Emergency Order

(Clarkston, GA)— In response to help prevent the spread of the current Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), the City of Clarkston City Council adopts a resolution effective 12:01 am, March 29, declaring a public health emergency requiring the following, including, but not limited to:

1. All residents shall stay at home or place of residence and continue to maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet while using shared or outdoor space;
2. All residents may leave their home or place of residence for essential activities such as obtaining food or medicine or to engage in outdoor exercise;
3. Assemblages, Events, and Gatherings continue to be prohibited unless they involve essential services such as in hospitals, home family settings, or grocery stores;
4. Prohibiting the use of public facilities including playground equipment, benches, pavilions, and water fountains.
5. Continue to strongly encourage social distancing of at least 6 feet.
