A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF CLARKSTON, GEORGIA

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation is in the process of expanding Interstate 285 by adding an additional lane to the highway;

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation has added sound barriers to many other communities along Interstate 285 as it goes through the process of adding an additional lane to the highway;

WHEREAS, many Clarkston residents are continually disturbed by the noise from the current traffic on Interstate 285, which negatively affects the quality of life of many Clarkston residents;

WHEREAS, adding an additional lane to Interstate 285 will only increase the number of cars on the highway and thus increase the noise from Interstate 285, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Clarkston, that the City of Clarkston hereby calls on the Georgia Department of Transportation to provide sound barriers between Interstate 285 and the City of Clarkston to protect Clarkston residents from the noise of the cars traveling on Interstate 285.
