This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and modifies the original bid documents. The following items shall take precedence over the originally published bid documents for the above-named project and shall become a part of the contract documents.

See questions asked on BidNet and the responses provided (Q5-Q):

- 1. Is it acceptable to utilize international manufacturers for LEDs requested?
 - a. The City hopes the materials are made in the US, in case of repairs.
- 2. Are background checks required for installers?
 - a. Not required for the installation, since the sign is outside, but if you know the person has legal matters pending, do not send over for the installation.
- 3. Does this project fall under prevailing wage requirements?
 - a. No, this project does not fall under prevailing wage requirements.
- 4. Is engineering required for this?
 - a. The bidding company should have an understanding of the requirements and specifications of the bid documents.
- 5. Can you confirm if it is acceptable to provide a lump sum cost for the manufacturing with warranty, software service and installation kit?
 - a. Itemize the items on the Cost Proposal Form and submit the final cost as a lump sum.
- 6. Is it mandatory to provide subcontractor details, specifically for the subcontractor responsible for removal, disposal, and installation?
 - a. Yes, subcontractors are to be listed.
- 7. Please confirm if a bid bond is needed with bid and a performance and payment bond is needed once awarded.
 - a. No bid bond is required for this project, make sure you include your COI in the bid package.
